

INLAND EMPIRE CHRISTMAS TREE ASSOCIATION HISTORICAL INFORMATION

Over the past forty plus years Christmas tree growers in the Inland Empire have gathered together to share information, and stay up-to-date on leading trends and technology. These growers, while originally several separate organizations, joined together to form what is now known as the **Inland Empire Christmas**Tree Association (IECTA). The following shows the chronology leading us to today's IECTA.

- February 7, 1963 Idaho Christmas Tree Growers Association, founded.
- ➤ Also in the early 60's Montana Christmas Tree Association, founded.
- ➤ 1981 Idaho Christmas Tree Grower's Association changed name to Inland Empire Christmas Tree Association.
- In 1992, the Inland Empire Christmas Tree Association hosted the National Christmas Tree Association's annual meeting in Spokane, WA.
- In 2004, the Montana Christmas Tree Association and the Inland Empire Christmas Tree Association combined, retaining the name, Inland Empire Christmas Tree Association.
- 2004 2007 Marvin Kaschke of Polson, Montana held position of National Director.
- 2008 2012 James Storms of Garfield, WA currently holds the position of National Director
